Platform Specific Model (PSM) A model of a subsystem that includes information about the specific technology that is used in the realization of it on a specific [Computing Platform](#), and hence possibly contains elements that are specific to the platform. A view of a system from the platform specific viewpoint, combining the specifications in the [Platform Independent Model \(PIM\)](#) with the details that specify how that system uses a particular type of platform
